

Carriage for Forklift

Carriage for Forklift - There are actually 4 sizes of hook type tine carriages rated by the fork carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type tine carriages have been the same.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is around 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades could differ by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the blade. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
